Luke gives us a picture of the early community of disciples in Jerusalem and how people were attracted to come to them for blessing and healing.

2nd Reading Apocalypse 1:9-13, 17-19

John recounts the vision that led to his writing this book, the Apocalypse or Revelation. The risen Jesus speaks to him and commissions him to set down all that he sees regarding the present and the future.

Acclamation: Jn 20: 19-31

*Alleluia, alleluia!
Jesus said: "You believe because you can see me.
Happy are those who have not seen and yet believe."
Alleluia!*

Gospel: John 20: 19-31

The risen Jesus make himself present to his disciples on two occasions. He commissions them to continue his work. Then Thomas makes the supreme confession of faith.
